LICENSING BOARD MINUTES January 14, 2019

Meeting called to order. Present were, Chairman Phil Antonelli, Board Member Brian McCarthy, Board Member Phil Arloro, Detective Michael Lavey and Attorney Keith Slattery,

1. Bearmoose Brewing, 1934 Revere Beach Parkway, Jeff Wetzel co-owner appeared before the License Board to apply for a new Farmers Series Brewing Permit. Chairman Antonelli reads the Legal Notice.

The Chairman makes an addendum that Jeff the owner informed the Board that there are four commercial businesses that touch 1934 Revere Beach Parkway and he was not able to notify them. The abutter notification is generally for residential areas and the Board will go forward with the application. If there are any concerns they will be address at the next meeting. Brian McCarthy seconds the motion. The Boards vote and approves to move forward.

Jeff Wetzel, co-owner starts his presentation. He is in the process of obtaining all the necessary permits to start construction there. They plan on having a capacity of 120; their hours will be Thursday, Friday, and Saturday 12 PM to 11 PM and Sunday 12 PM to 6 PM. They will have the proper certifications such as crowd control managers and tip certification. Jeff will be at the business all day Thursday and Friday and his co-owner will be there on Saturday and Sunday. They are hoping to open by March. They plan on serving and selling retail. They will not be distributing, they will only sell on site. They may have some kind of food that will be premade. They are also going to list multiply managers on the license. The Chairman asks 3

times if anyone is in favor and 3 times if anyone is opposed. Member Brian McCarthy votes for favorable action and Member Phil Arloro seconds it. The Board votes in favor of granting the license. 0 nays 3 yays. Motion passed

2. Everett Bar appeared to have their hours extended back to 1 AM. There probation period was over in September, 2018 and there has not been any issues. The license will also list Mario Navarro as the manager. The Board agrees to extend the hours back to 1 AM.
