CITY OF EVERETT INSPECTIONAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT LAUNCHES ONLINE PERMITTING SERVICE

Mayor Carlo DeMaria and Inspectional Services Director Jim Soper would like to announce that a new online system for obtaining building permits has been launched on the City of Everett website. This new system is the first in a multiphase project to improve customer service and increase accessibility to government services.

The new Online Permit Center allows Everett residents to apply, pay for, track and receive permits and inspections. Residents can now obtain all building, electrical, mechanical, gas and plumbing permits online.

To use the system, residents must first take about five minutes to create a one-time online registration. Applicants may then make a permit application and attach any necessary plans, pictures, specs or other documents.

Users will have the ability to view the status of their application and comments from other departments, including whether additional information is required. Users can also track all recent permitting history for any parcel in the city.

Online payment for the permit will be made through PayPal. Users are always welcome to pay in person by check or credit/debit card.
