Mayor Carlo DeMaria recently joined the Joint Committee for Children's Health Care (JCCHCE) for the opening of their new office space in Everett City Hall, located in Room 2. The new office will house both the JCCHCE and the Everett Public Schools Parent Information Center. The new office can accommodate more residents and community members, and will be a one-stop shop for children to have easy access to affordable health care and information on public schools.

Mayor DeMaria stated, "Everett is so fortunate to have our public schools and non-profit organizations working together to assist children and families with health insurance, education and information on programs. Just this past weekend, over 100 children signed up for affordable health coverage all thanks to JCCHCE."

It also provides many services to parents and teens in Everett, such as Parent University, and a community service group.
