

The Committee of the Whole met on Monday, March 9, 2020 at 6:45pm

Members present were Councilor Rosa DiFlorio, presiding, Councilors Gerly Adrien, Fred Capone, Anthony DiPierro, John Hanlon, Jimmy Le, Michael Marchese, Stephanie Martins and Peter Napolitano.

Members absent were Councilors Wayne Matewsky and Michael Mclaughlin.

The Committee considered a Resolution offered by Councilor Michael Marchese; That the Mayor appear to discuss the use of campaign funds being directed to criminal attorneys.

Chairperson DiFlorio referenced that the matter was addressed at the last regular meeting. Councilor Marchese mentioned that he would still like to have another meeting since there may be other questions that need to be asked. Councilor DiPierro remarked that he respected Councilor Marchese's opinion but doesn't see the need to rehash what was already discussed. The Committee considered an Order offered by Councilor Rosa DiFlorio: That the property managers of 15 and 21 Staples Avenue appear at this meeting to address ongoing issues at both properties and that a police log be provided.

Councilor Rosa DiFlorio, the Sponsor was also present. The Committee was informed that the Property Management Company was invited but informed Councilor DiFlorio that they could not be present.

Councilor DiFlorio informed the Committee that she had spoken with both the Property Management Company and their Attorney regarding the Police incident reports and they informed her that they could only attend during regular business hours of 9am to 5pm, but requested that the Police incident reports reflect the actual unit in which the incident has occurred so that the Property Management company could take corrective action. Councilor DiFlorio recommended that the matter be referred to the Police Chief and the City Solicitor to inform the Property Managements Attorney Janet Oulousian Arsonson that the City will commence enforcing the Public Nuisance Ordinance at these locations.

The Committee voted: To report back to the City Council with a recommendation to refer to the Police Chief and City Solicitor to commence enforcing the Public Nuisance Ordinance at these locations.
