 - a. Stand Back Lines at crosswalks were School Zones for Bus Lanes **Refer to City Engineer**
 - b. Discuss issues on Waverly St during snow emergency **Change Ordinance to be uniform with the City to Odd or Even side of street**
 - c. Proposed by Steve Altieri, that traffic lights at the intersection of Ferry St and Shute St be staggered to allow Shute St to turn left onto Ferry St while Glendale St is delayed then extended OR Glendale St can get a green first while Shute St is delayed followed by an extended green for Shute St Gridlock is also a common problem at this intersection so I would also include (Don't block the box/intersection) signs be installed **Tabled,**
